A special thanks to Laura Leicht for the lunch she did for us after the Memorial Service at Mt Baker Cemetery and all the Memorabilia she set up for the display.


And again to all the volunteer who do our pancake breakfast the last Sunday of each month, they are having big turn outs – Thank You !




